1996 Broman Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon

Tasting Notes

This wine is a blend of fruit collected from hillside vineyards located on the eastern side of the Napa Valley as well as on the Valley Floor between Rutherford and St. Helena. The blend consists of 82 percent Cabernet Sauvignon, 16 percent Cabernet Franc and 2 percent Merlot. The wine was aged for over 30 months in French Oak Barrels ranging from 2 to 5 years in age.

Winemakers Comments:

The 1996 Broman Cabernet Sauvignon has rich, ripe berry characteristics balanced with hints of mint, leather and oak. You will find the wine to be full in the mouth, soft and plump on the pallet, with just enough tannin backbone to provide a long, lingering finish. This wine is ready for either immediate enjoyment or can be cellared for a few more years.
