Tasting Notes

The 1997 Broman Napa Valley Cabernet was picked from vineyards located on Spring Mountain and Rutherford. It is 83 percent Cabernet Sauvignon and 17 percent Merlot. The wine was aged in French oak for 23 months.

Winemakers Comments:

Flavors include cherry, plum and dark currant. The nose has dark cherry, French lavender, mint laced smoke and hints of java and cocoa. You will notice more tannins in this wine, which is indicative of the production year and also means this wine should cellar longer.
