2000 Broman Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon

Tasting Notes

The 2000 Broman Napa Valley Cabernet was sourced from vineyards located high atop Howell Mountain, as well as from a few small vineyards on the Valley floor. The blend for this wine consists of 92 percent Cabernet Sauvignon, 6 percent Merlot, and 2 percent Cabernet Franc. The wine was aged in French oak for 24 months.

Winemaker's Notes:

Full and juicy is a perfect description of our 2000 Cabernet Sauvignon. Ripe cherry, blackberry and cassis aromas invite you to take your first sip. This wine gains complexity, presenting scents of mocha, cedar, pencil shavings and a trace of mint. A full, plush mouth feel gives way to a long finish with soft tannins. This wine will be a terrific complement to any meal, but is mellow enough now to drink on its own.
