Tasting Notes

The Broman 2000 Napa Valley Merlot was produced from grapes picked from two vineyards on the valley floor. This wine was aged in French oak for 24 months, and the blend is 98 percent Merlot and 2 percent Cabernet Sauvignon.

Winemaker's Notes:

This Broman Napa Valley Merlot is a well- integrated blend that has wonderful complexity and layers of flavors. You will notice cherries and plums with slight hints of freshly cracked black pepper on the nose. The middle is plump and full with ripe fruit, slight earthy tones with traces of leather. This wine has a nice long, velvety finish.
