2001 Broman Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon

Tasting Notes

The 2001 Broman Napa Valley Cabernet was sourced from the esteemed Dr. Crane vineyard in Saint Helena, as well as the sought after Georges III vineyard in Rutherford. Bob rounded out this wine with fruit from Oak Knoll district and blended 4 percent Merlot for added smoothness and complexity. This wine was aged in French oak barrels for 24 months. Thirty percent of the barrels were new; the remainder ranged in age from 2-5 years old.

Winemaker's Notes:

Bob believes that the 2001 Cabernet Sauvignon is our best wine yet! Complex, yet smooth and supple, this wine presents aromas of plum, pomegranate and cranberry fruits with traces of cocoa, leather and cedar. Full and rich in the mouth with fine integrated tannins; our Cabernet has a long, smooth finish.
