## 2001 Broman Napa Valley Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon

### Tasting Notes

*The grapes for the 2001 Broman Cabernet Sauvignon Reserve are mainly from the esteemed Dr. Crane Vineyard in Saint Helena. Bob also used fruit from the Georges III Vineyard in Rutherford for balance and added complexity. This wine is 100% Cabernet Sauvignon, and was aged in French oak for 24 months.*

### Winemaker's Notes:

Reminiscent of black forest cake, this wine shows gobs of dark cherry and chocolate with chewy tannins. Our Reserve Cabernet is rounded out by accents of leather and toasty oak. This wine is absolutely beautiful now and will age and continue to improve over the next 5-7 years.
